Events Announced in 2026 in Madison

From winter candlelight tours to summer riverfront festivals and fall harvest celebrations, Madison's 2026 community calendar is packed with events designed to showcase the city's culture, history, and hometown pride. City organizers are encouraging residents and visitors alike to "Save the 2026 Dates" as dozens of signature events return throughout the year.

The year kicks off in January with Night at the Museums on the Trolley Line on January 24, offering an after-hours look at Madison's historic attractions. February follows with Schokolade from February 7-14, bringing sweet treats and winter cheer, while March features Girl's Shopping Weekend, St. Paddy's Week Taste of Ireland Trolley Crawl, and the Hoosier Heroines Weekend Community Celebration.

Spring ushers in food and automotive favorites, including Hot Luck & Fiery Foods in April and Rumble on the River Car Show in May. June is one of the busiest months, highlighted by Madison in Bloom, Juneteenth Celebrations, Madison Pride 2026, and riverfront tastings at Wine, Stein & Barrel.

Summer events center on the Ohio River, with Madison Regatta fireworks and racing on July 3-5, the Roostertail Music Festival, and crowd-

pleasers like Wings & Wheels and Madison's BBQ Party in August. Music lovers can also enjoy Play Music on the Porch Day and Rockin' on the River Car Show & Concert.

As autumn arrives, Madison transitions into festival season with Fall Old Court Days, Chelsea Jubilee, Unbroken Circle Music Fest, and the Canaan Fall Festival & Pony Express Mail Run. Art, aviation, and heritage take center stage during the Madison Air Show, Madison Chautauqua Festival of Art, and Hispanic Cultural Day.

October brings home tours, poker runs, chili and brew tastings, and harvest celebrations, leading into a festive holiday season.

November and December events include MadHop Music Festival, Light Up Madison!, Nights Before Christmas Candlelight Tour of Homes, Festival of Trees, and A Very Merry Madison Christmas Parade & Celebration. Organizers note that these events represent only part of the city's offerings, with steamboat visits, trolley tours, and additional weekend activities added regularly.

With something happening nearly every weekend, Madison's 2026 calendar reflects a community deeply connected to its riverfront, its history, and its love of celebration. For a full list of events and updates, visit VisitMadison.org.




